The Presbytery of Lake Michigan will elect at its September 18, 2021, Stated Meeting one (1) Young Adult Advisory Delegate (YAAD) to attend the General Assembly, and one (1) Alternate YAAD delegate.

Members of the Nominating and Representation Committee solicit applications from young adults within the Presbytery who are interested in serving as a YAAD. If you wish to serve as a YAAD, please complete this **two-page application** and submit it **via email only**, with attachments, to office@lakemichiganpresbytery.org no later than **July 15, 2021**.

When reviewing applications to serve as a GA Young Adult Advisory Delegate, the Nominating and Representation Committee will consider the following criteria:

1. Strong technology, computer, and communication skills, since GA may be a hybrid of online and onsite attendance.
2. Past record of service to the presbytery and its congregations.
3. Commitment to continued service to the presbytery and its congregations following attendance at GA.
4. Diversity and geographic distribution concerns within the presbytery.
5. Endorsement by the candidate's pastor and Session.

Preference will be given to applicants from different congregations in successive General Assemblies.
